ABOUT THE WIPEOUT PLASTIC GRANT PROGRAM:

Through the Wipeout Plastic Grant Program, Skyline Hawai'i and partners provide \$10,000 grants to schools in Maui County for the purpose of purchasing and installing water bottle fill stations on school campus. The budget allows for approximately 2 - 3 fill stations, providing purified and chilled water, as well as a budget for installation. Applying schools will be responsible for coordinating and facilitating the purchase and installation of the water bottle fill stations, and are free to select the brand/model/style which best meet the unique needs of their campus. The water fill stations are intended as practical tools to encourage kids to utilize refillable bottles, and minimize disposable plastic waste from single use plastic bottles. As part of this program schools are encouraged to promote the use of reusable water bottles on campus; and are encouraged to provide students with information about plastic waste and the problems it poses for our Hawaii's marine environment.
